<u>Proposal</u>

The City of Toronto Planning Division has received an application to amend the Zoning By-law for the property at 500 Duplex Avenue to permit two infill residential rental buildings of 11- and 15-storeys in height, resulting in an additional 45,416 square metres of residential gross floor area the subject site. In total, this will result in an overall residential gross floor area of 64,635 square metres and a total site density of 6.46 Floor Space Index. The existing 34-storey rental apartment building would be retained with modifications some of the existing units. The total number of residential units would be 940 for the existing and proposed buildings. A total of 557 vehicular parking spaces and 771 bicycle parking spaces are proposed. A park block of 917 square metres is proposed in the southwest corner of the site.
